

**THIS CONTEST IS OPEN TO SELECT CANADIAN RESIDENTS ONLY
AND IS GOVERNED BY CANADIAN LAW**

1. KEY DATES:

The 2021 Virtual Summit for Cancer Immunotherapy Contest (the “**Contest**”) begins on November 21, 2021 and ends on November 22, 2021 (the “**Contest Period**”). The Contest will take place only during the 2021 Virtual Summit for Cancer Immunotherapy (the “**Virtual Event**”).

2. ELIGIBILITY:

Contest is open to select residents of Canada who: (i) are registered attendees of the Virtual Event; and (ii) have reached the legal age of majority in their province/territory of residence at the time of entry. The Contest is **not** open to: (i) attendees of the Virtual Event who are not age of majority residents of Canada; nor (ii) employees, representatives or agents (and those with whom such persons are domiciled, whether related or not) of BioCanRx (the “**Organizer**”), its associated and affiliated entities, advertising/promotion agencies and any other individual(s), entity or entities involved in the development, production, implementation, administration or fulfillment of the Contest (collectively with the Organizer, the “**Contest Parties**”).

3. HOW TO ENTER:

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. MAKING A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE OR OTHERWISE IMPACT YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. THE VIRTUAL EVENT IS FREE TO ATTEND.

While participating in the Virtual Event, you can earn entries (each, an “**Entry**” and collectively the “**Entries**”), as follows:

- **Booth Passport Entries:** You can earn a maximum of one (1) “**Booth Passport Entry**” when you like, comment on and sign-up via email in relation to at least five (5) out of six (6) exhibitor booths at the Virtual Event. You can opt-out of receiving emails at anytime without impacting your chances of winning in this Contest. There is a limit of one (1) Booth Passport Entry per person.
- **Networking Session Entries:** You can earn a maximum of one (1) “**Networking Session Entry**” when you attend the Networking Session at the Virtual Event. There is a limit of one (1) Networking Session Entry per person.
- **HQP Development Day Entries:** You can earn a maximum of one (1) “**HQP Development Day Entry**” when you attend the HQP Development Day Session on Friday, November 19, 2021 at the Virtual Event. There is a limit of one (1) HQP Development Day Entry per person.
- **Community Leaderboard Entries:** You will automatically earn one (1) “**Community Leaderboard Entry**” by participating as a contributor to the Community Leaderboard at the Virtual Event. There is a limit of one (1) Community Leaderboard Entry per person.

4. ENTRY CONDITIONS:

If it is discovered by the Organizer (using any evidence or other information made available to or otherwise discovered by the Organizer) that any person has attempted to use multiple names, multiple identities, multiple email addresses, and/or any automated, macro, script, robotic or other system(s) or program(s) and/or any other means not in keeping with the Organizer’s interpretation of the letter and/or spirit of these Rules to enter or otherwise participate in or to disrupt this Contest; then they may be disqualified from the Contest in the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer. The Contest Parties and each of their respective officers, directors, agents, representatives, successors and assigns (collectively, the “**Released Parties**”) are not responsible for (and have no liability in relation to) late, lost, misdirected, delayed, incomplete or incompatible Entries (all of which are void).

5. VERIFICATION:

All Entries and entrants are subject to verification at any time and for any reason. The Organizer reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Organizer – including, without limitation, government issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying an individual’s eligibility to participate in this Contest; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of any Entry and/or other information entered (or purportedly entered) for the purposes of this Contest; and/or (iii) for any other reason the Organizer deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering this Contest in accordance with the Organizer’s interpretation of the letter and spirit of these Rules. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of the Organizer within the timeline specified by the Organizer may result in disqualification in the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer. The sole determinant of the time for the purposes of this Contest will be the official time-keeping device(s) used by the Organizer.

6. THE PRIZES:

There will be a total of ten (10) prizes (each, a “Prize”) available to be won as follows:

- **Booth Passport Prizes:** There will be a total of two (2) “Booth Passport Prizes” available to be won – each consisting of a \$500 CAD gift card. Use of a gift card is subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable issuer. There is a limit of one (1) Booth Passport Prize per person.
- **Networking Session Prize:** There will be a total of one (1) “Networking Session Prize” available to be won - consisting of a \$250 CAD gift card. Use of the gift card is subject to the terms and conditions of the issuer. There is a limit of one (1) Networking Session Prize per person.
- **HQP Development Day Prizes:** There will be a total of five (5) “HQP Development Day Prizes” available to be won – each consisting of a \$50 CAD gift card. Use of a gift card is subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable issuer. There is a limit of one (1) HQP Development Day Prize per person.
- **Community Leaderboard Prizes:** There will be a total of two (2) “Community Leaderboard Prizes” available to be won – each consisting of a \$500 CAD gift card. Use of a gift card is subject to the terms and conditions of the applicable issuer. There is a limit of one (1) Community Leaderboard Prize per person.

The following general conditions apply to each Prize: (i) Prize must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable, assignable or convertible to cash (except as may be specifically permitted by Organizer in its sole and absolute discretion); (ii) no substitutions are permitted, except at Organizer’s option; and (iii) Organizer reserves the right at any time to substitute the Prize for any reason with a prize or prize component(s) of equal or greater retail value, including, without limitation, but solely at the Organizer’s sole discretion, a cash award.

None of the Released Parties makes any representation or offers any warranty, express or implied, as to the quality or fitness of any Prize awarded in connection with the Contest. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, each confirmed winner understands and acknowledges that they may not seek reimbursement or pursue any legal or equitable remedy from either the Organizer or any of the other Released Parties should the Prize fail to be fit for its purpose or is in any way unsatisfactory.

7. ELIGIBLE WINNER SELECTION PROCESS AND ODDS OF WINNING:

- **Networking Session Prize:** On November 22, 2021 in Ottawa, ON at approximately 4 p.m. ET, one (1) eligible entrant will be selected by random draw from among all eligible Networking Session Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Networking Session Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.
- **HQP Development Day Prizes:** On November 22, 2021 in Ottawa, ON at approximately 4 p.m. ET, five (5) eligible entrants will be selected by random draw from among all eligible HQP Development Day Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible HQP Development Day Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.
- **Community Leaderboard Prizes:** On November 22, 2021 in Ottawa, ON at approximately 4 p.m. ET, the Organizer will determine (in its sole and absolute discretion) the two (2) eligible entrants who are at the top of the Community Leaderboard. The odds of winning depend on the number of participants on the Community Leaderboard and how frequently such entrants engage with the Community Leaderboard during the Virtual Event.

8. ELIGIBLE WINNER NOTIFICATION PROCESS:

The Organizer or its designated representative will make a minimum of two ([2]) attempts to contact each eligible winner via email within fourteen ([14]) business days of selection. If an eligible winner cannot be contacted as outlined above, or if there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then they may, in the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer, be disqualified (and, if disqualified, will forfeit all rights to the applicable Prize) and the Organizer reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion and time permitting, to select an alternate eligible entrant for the applicable Prize(s) in accordance with Rule 7 (in which case the foregoing provisions of this section shall apply to such newly selected eligible winner).

9. ELIGIBLE WINNER CONFIRMATION PROCESS:

NO ONE IS A WINNER UNLESS AND UNTIL THE ORGANIZER OFFICIALLY CONFIRMS THEM AS A WINNER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THESE RULES. BEFORE BEING DECLARED A CONFIRMED PRIZE WINNER, each eligible winner will be required to: (a) correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without mechanical or other aid (which may, in the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer, be administered online, by email or other electronic means, by telephone, or in the Organizer’s form of declaration and release); and (b) sign and return within seven ([7]) business days of notification the Organizer’s declaration and

release form, which (among other things): (i) confirms compliance with these Rules; (ii) acknowledges acceptance of the applicable Prize (as awarded); (iii) releases the Organizer and all of the other Released Parties from any and all liability in connection with this Contest, their participation therein and/or the awarding and use/misuse of the applicable Prize or any portion thereof; and (iv) agrees to the publication, reproduction and/or other use of their name, city and province/territory of residence, voice, statements about the Contest and/or photograph or other likeness without further notice or compensation, in any publicity or advertisement carried out by or on behalf of the Organizer in any manner whatsoever, including print, broadcast or the internet. 10. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws. The decisions of the Organizer with respect to all aspects of this Contest are final and binding on all entrants without right of appeal. ANYONE DEEMED BY THE ORGANIZER TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE ORGANIZER'S INTERPRETATION OF THE LETTER AND/OR SPIRIT OF THESE RULES FOR ANY REASON IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IN THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF THE ORGANIZER AT ANY TIME.

The Released Parties will not be liable for: (i) any failure of any website, platform or device during the Contest; (ii) any malfunction or other problems of any nature whatsoever, including, without limitation, those relating to the telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment or software; (iii) the failure of any Entry and/or other information to be received, captured or recorded for any reason whatsoever, including, but not limited to, technical problems or traffic congestion on the internet or at any website; (iv) any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer or other device related to or resulting from participating in the Contest; (v) anyone being incorrectly and/or mistakenly identified as a winner or eligible winner; and/or (vi) any combination of the above.

The Organizer reserves the right, subject only to the approval of the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux (the "Régie") in Quebec, to withdraw, amend or suspend this Contest (or to amend these Rules) in any way, in the event of any cause beyond the reasonable control of the Organizer that interferes with the proper conduct of this Contest as contemplated by these Rules, including, without limitation, any error, problem, computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud or failure of any kind whatsoever. Any attempt to undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest in any way (as determined by Organizer in its sole and absolute discretion) may be a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, the Organizer reserves the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Organizer reserves the right, subject only to the approval of the Régie in Quebec, to cancel, amend or suspend this Contest, or to amend these Rules, in any way without prior notice or obligation, in the event of any accident, printing, administrative, or other error of any kind, or for any other reason whatsoever. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Organizer reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to administer an alternate test of skill as it deems appropriate based on the circumstances and/or to comply with applicable law.

For Quebec residents: Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the board only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.

By entering this Contest, each entrant expressly consents to the Organizer, its agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted for the purpose of administering the Contest and in accordance with Organizer's privacy policy. This section does not limit any other consent(s) that an individual may provide the Organizer or others in relation to the collection, use and/or disclosure of their personal information.

The Organizer reserves the right, subject only to the approval of the Régie in Quebec, to adjust any of the dates, timeframes and/or other Contest mechanics stipulated in these Rules, to the extent deemed necessary by the Organizer, for purposes of verifying compliance by any entrant, Entry and/or other information with these Rules, or as a result of any technical or other problems, or in light of any other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Organizer, in its sole and absolute discretion, affect the proper administration of the Contest as contemplated in these Rules, or for any other reason.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of these English Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including, but not limited to, the French version of these Rules, point of sale, television, print or online advertising and/or any instructions or interpretations of these Rules given by any representative of the Organizer, the terms and conditions of these English Rules shall prevail, govern and control to the fullest extent permitted by law.

The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Rules shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, these Rules shall otherwise remain in effect and shall be construed in accordance with the terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Rules or the rights and obligations of participants, Organizer or any of the other the Released Parties in connection with the Contest will be governed by and construed in accordance with the domestic laws of the Province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws. The parties hereby consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the courts located in Ontario in any action to enforce (or otherwise relating to) these Rules or relating to this Contest.
