

Learning Institute 2026 Program Details – Academic Scholars

What is the Learning Institute?

The Learning Institute was formed in 2017 by the BioCanRx Cancer Community Partnership to pair together patient and Academic Scholars in the cancer immunotherapy community. The Learning Institute fosters a bidirectional model of learning where Patient Scholars and Academic Scholars learn from each other. The Learning Institute also encourages and supports Patient Scholars within the Summit for Cancer Immunotherapy (Summit4CI). It ensures that scientific research at the Summit4CI is being communicated understandably so that research can be shared with Patient Scholars and partners.

What is an Academic Scholar?

Academic Scholars/highly qualified personnel (HQP) are defined as individuals working or studying in the cancer immunotherapy field, and is inclusive of undergraduate students, post-doctoral fellows, research associates, medical students, and others engaged in research.

What will you do?

- Connect with Patient Scholars, who are individuals with lived cancer experience (either as a patient, caregiver, family member, or support person), and engage in discussion about the patient perspective in research
- Attend the in-person national Summit for Cancer Immunotherapy (Summit4CI) with internationally recognized speakers, presentations, poster sessions and more!
- Listen to talks from leading scientists on the cutting-edge research across a broad range of cancer immunotherapy topics with the goal of reinterpreting research into plain language
- Work in partnership with Patient Scholars and learn how to break down complex scientific topics and distill key messages through oral and written communication
- Build connections and network with researchers, academics, students, patients, and other like-minded individuals in the cancer immunotherapy community
- Spend time during the conference engaging with Learning Institute participants outside of Learning Institute sessions

Eligibility

All HQP are eligible to apply.

If accepted as a participant of the Learning Institute, your registration to attend the Summit4Cl will be covered by BioCanRx. The expectation is that HQP participating in the Learning Institute will support their own travel either via a BioCanRx Travel Award via the Abstract Submission mechanism (November 7, 2025), and/or supervisory support to attend the Summit4Cl proper.



What are the expectations?

By participating as a member of the Learning Institute, you will be expected to:

- Meet/connect <u>at least once</u> with your Patient Scholar in advance of the Summit4CI, outside of scheduled Learning Institute activities (virtual or in person)
- Attend multiple pre-summit webinars including:
 - Orientation
 - Cancer biology 101
 - Immunotherapy 101
 - Science communication activity

Each Webinar will be 1-1.5 hours long. This list is not exhaustive and may be updated as new webinars are added. Exact dates and times are TBD.

- Attend the in-person Summit4Cl at the Westin Bayshore, Vancouver, BC for the duration of the conference (March 29-31, 2026) and attend all related Learning Institute activities in collaboration with your Academic Scholar partner, including:
 - Meet & Greet
 - Knowledge Exchange Sessions
 - Patient-Researcher Roundtable
 - Post-Summit Virtual Knowledge Exchange Session

- Assist in co-authoring the dissemination report following the Summit4CI along with Patient Scholar partners
- Have a willingness to actively engage with your Patient Scholar buddy and work with them throughout the pre-summit training and conference, as well as engage with other Learning Institute participants throughout the Summit4CI
