The 5 Main Components of the Learning Institute



Familizaration with basic cancer biology, immunotherapy, and science communication best practices in advance of the Summit for Cancer Immunotherapy.



The buddy system involves pairing a technical expert (academic scholar) with people with lived cancer experience (patient scholars) for sharing of their respective expertise.



KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE SYSTEM Buddy groups get together and discuss the research they have heard. After discussion, buddy groups present to the group and explain the key take-aways of the research.



Learning Institute participants and BioCanRx funded investigators meet to learn about patient engagement best practices. They then engage in a dialogue about ongoing research projects, including the challenges and opportunities for patient partnership.



Co-authorship of a community dissemination report outlining key takeaways from the Summit. The report is available to the public and is written in lay language to make it accessible.
